#### PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS

Coverage: N/A

Clean Up: Clean rim of container after each use. Brushes can be cleaned with warm, soapy water.

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area. Keep from freezing. Keep away from heat sources. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store in a well ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children. Do not take internally.

**Shelf Life:** At least one year after opening in a well sealed container.

### **APPLICATION**

Use your Beeswax Distressing Bar to help create a weathered, distressed look on your painted furniture.

After your first paint coat has dried, rub the wax bar on the edges of your project, and any raised areas on which wear and tear would naturally occur. Follow up with a second coat of paint in a contrasting color. Let dry completely.

Use fine-grit sandpaper to effortlessly rub away paint from the areas where the wax was applied for a beautiful weathered look.

Made in Canada from 100% pure Canadian beeswax.
