DESCRIPTION

Bring out the details of your painted furniture with Country Chic's environmentally-friendly furniture glaze. The pre-tinted glazes can be applied over any paint color to add depth, dimensions, and an antique look, or apply it over raw wood to create a stained effect. The clear glaze can be mixed with any Country Chic paint color in a 4 part glaze to 1 part paint ratio.

Clean Up: Clean rim of container after each use. Brushes can be cleaned with warm, soapy water.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area. Keep from freezing. Keep away from heat sources. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store in a well ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children. Do not take internally.

Shelf Life: At least one year after opening in a well sealed container.

APPLICATION

Once thoroughly shaken and stirred, apply your pre-tinted glaze or custom glaze mix after your final coat of paint has dried completely. Simply brush it on with a paint brush and use a damp lint-free cloth to remove the excess as desired. For detailed instructions and tutorials, please visit www.countrychicpaint.com.

Apply when the temperature is between 10°C (50°F) and 30°C (86°F) and the relative humidity is below 85%. Brushes can be cleaned with warm, soapy water.
