DESCRIPTION

This Clear Bonding Primer is an environmentally-friendly preparation product designed to be used when painting non-porous surfaces like glass, metal, and faux-wood. The product is clear, allowing you to distress your piece and still see the original wood tones underneath.

PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS

Coverage: 120+ sq. ft/quart

VOCs: < 1 grams/liter

PH: 8.5 - 9.5

Clean Up: Clean rim of container after each use. Brushes can be cleaned with warm, soapy water.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area. Keep from freezing. Keep away from heat sources. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store in a well ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children. Do not take internally.

Shelf Life: At least one year after opening in a well sealed container.

Disposal: Dispose of contents/container in accordance with paint collection facility's instructions.

First Aid: In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of water as a precaution. Wash skin with soap and water. If ingested, call physician or the Poison Control Centre.

APPLICATION

Before you start, make sure your project is clean, dust-free, and dry. Shake and stir the Clear Bonding Primer well, then apply it to your project with a synthetic-bristle paint brush or a painting sponge. Apply paint after allowing your coat of Primer to dry for at least 12 hours.

Please note: this product does not block tannin or nicotine bleed through. A Shellac-based product is recommended for this purpose.
