PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS

Coverage: 20+ sq. ft/4 oz

Clean Up: Clean rim of container after each use. Brushes can be cleaned with warm, soapy water.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area. Keep from freezing. Keep away from heat sources. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store in a well ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children. Do not take internally.

APPLICATION

Apply a thin layer of wax to your fully dry, painted furniture with a wax brush or a lint-free cloth. Buff your piece with a lint-free cloth until the surface feels silky smooth and is no longer tacky.

Contains beeswax and natural oils; completely free of solvents.
